THE iCARE-2 PROGRAM MAY BE WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR!

iCARE-2 is an international fellowship program co-funded by AIRC and the European Union, intended to **promote the mobility of experienced researchers to and from Italy**.

iCARE-2 offers these types of **3-year fellowships**:

- Outgoing Fellowships, for researchers who have worked in Italy for more than three years, interested in a research experience in a scientific institution located in a different country than Italy.
- **Incoming Fellowships**, for non-Italian scientists interested in a research experience in a scientific institution in Italy.
- Reintegration Fellowships, for Italian researchers who have worked in a country outside Italy for at least two out of the last three years, and who wish to return and work in a research center in Italy.

The 2019 iCARE-2 call is now **open!** Deadline for submission **June 5, 2019**.
